What is the Seniors Co-Payment Program?

If you are a low-income senior, you can have your Ontario Drug Benefit annual deductible waived and co-payment fees reduced to \$2 by applying for the Seniors Co-Payment Program

You should apply if you are:

- A senior living alone with a net annual income that is less than or equal to \$25,000, or
- A senior living with a spouse and your combined net annual income is less than or equal to \$41,500

What You Need to Apply:

- 1. You and your spouse (if applicable) must provide your Ontario health card number and Social Insurance Number (SIN).
- 2. If you have a spouse, both of you will need to sign the application.
