ONTARIO SENIORS DENTAL CARE PROGRAM

The Ministry of Health in Ontario now offers a low-income senior dental care program. You must apply to determine your eligibility.

You can apply for the program if you:

- > Are 65 years of age or older;
- > Are a resident of Ontario;
- Have an annual net income of \$22,200 or less for a single senior or a combined annual net income of \$37,100 or less for a couple; and
- Have no other form of dental benefits, including private insurance or dental coverage under another government program such as Ontario Works (OW), Ontario Disability Support Program (ODSP) or Non-Insured Health Benefits.

This program offers assistance with basic dental treatment and services including check-ups, fillings, cleanings, root canals etc.
